TCA can now test to IEC 60601-1: 2005 3rd ed.

TCA can now test to the new IEC standard covering both medical electrical equipment and medical electrical systems. The standard introduces two new principles by extending the basic safety requirements to include essential performance of the medical device or system (for example the accuracy of delivering substances to patients, display of physiological data etc) and a requirement for manufacturers to have a risk management process in place and to comply with ISO 14971.
